How Do I Register for Camp? This year we will be using campsEZ.com as our registration site. We plan to open Camper Registration on May 10th and will provide tips for you on how to sign up. Please know that all payments must be received online in order to complete registration and to save your spot. Links to our registration site will be available on our website after May 10th.

Do I bring my own money for the Camp Store? Not this year! Camp Store Credit for each camper will be issued at the beginning of the week and is included in the Camp Fee.
