

Camp Tapawingo Camper Guidelines Update 2021

Masks will not be required but Campers are welcome to wear them.

All Campers will be placed in small cabin groups and on Teams of 30 campers or less. These Teams will remain together without mixing with the other teams.

Programmed activities will be designed in a way to have teams be together while maintaining our safety protocols of “together yet separate.”

Camp Tapawingo will continue to follow the guidelines for Organizational Camps as determined by the Oregon Health Authority, Polk County Health Department and the CDC. The safety of our Campers and Staff is very important to us and we appreciate your cooperation.

Camp Tapawingo is required to collect the following information for contact tracing purposes:

- Adult name(s) completing drop-off and pick-up
- Youth names, arrival and departure date and times
- Name of any staff or person coming in contact with youth
